### Workstream Updates

**Workforce and Education**

- Mae gwaith yn mynd rhagddo ar hyn o bryd i baratoi ar gyfer lansiad swyddogol ‘*Creu Model Gweithlu Delweddu GIG Cymru. Strategaeth ar gyfer Datblygu Model i'r Gweithlu Radioleg yng Nghymru*. Bydd Tîm y Rhaglen yn cyflwyno'r Strategaeth yn nigwyddiad Gweithlu Diagnostig AaGIC ar 29<sup>ain</sup> Mawrth 2023, a chaiff ei dosbarthu'n eang wedi hynny. Bydd y Strategaeth ar gael ar ein gwefan o ddechrau Ebrill ymlaen. Byddwn hefyd yn rhoi sylw arbennig i'r Strategaeth yn ein cylchlythyr nesaf.
- Mae Cynllun cynhwysfawr wedi cael ei ddatblygu ar gyfer y Rhaglen er mwyn gweithredu'r argymhellion yn y 'Strategaeth ar gyfer Datblygu Model i'r Gweithlu Radioleg yng Nghymru'. Mae'r Grŵp Trawsnewid y Gweithlu Delweddu ac Addysg (IWETG) yn cael ei sefydlu i oruchwylion'r trefniadau ar gyfer rheoli a gweithredu'r cynllun hwn. Cytunwyd ar Gylch Gorchwyl ac aelodaeth y grŵp hwn a threfnwyd y cyfarfod cyntaf ar gyfer dechrau'r chwarter nesaf.
- Mae'r prosiect cyntaf yn y cynllun gwaith hwn wedi'i sefydlu, gyda'r ffocws ar sut allwn ni ddatblygu'r Gweithlu Cefnogi Delweddu Diagnostig. Cynhaliwyd gweithdy cwmpasu cychwynnol gyda rhanddeiliaid o Fyrrdau Iechyd GIG Cymru, Bron Brawf Cymru, AaGIC a Chymdeithas y Radiograffwyr ar 28<sup>ain</sup> Chwefror 2023.
- Cynhaliwyd Adolygiad Codio ESR ar gyfer y gweithlu Delweddu Diagnostig gyda Phenaethiaid Proffesiynol Radiograffeg ar 15<sup>fed</sup> Chwefror 2023. Mae dogfen ganllaw ddiwygiedig wrthi'n cael ei datblygu gyda Thîm

- Work is currently underway to prepare for the official launch of '*Building the NHS Wales Imaging Workforce Model. Strategy for Developing a Radiology Workforce Model for Wales*'. The Programme Team will be presenting the Strategy at the HEIW Diagnostic Workforce event on 29<sup>th</sup> March 2023, with widespread distribution to follow. The Strategy will be available on our website from early April. There will also be a special feature on the Strategy within our next newsletter.

- A comprehensive Programme Plan has been developed to take forward the recommendations within the 'Strategy for Developing a Radiology Workforce Model for Wales'. The Imaging Workforce and Education Transformation Group (IWETG) is being established to oversee the management and execution of this plan. Terms of Reference and membership of this group has been agreed with the first meeting scheduled for early next quarter.
- The first project within this workplan has been established, looking at how we can develop the Diagnostic Imaging Support Workforce. An initial scoping workshop with stakeholders from NHS Wales Health Boards, Breast Test Wales, HEIW and the Society of Radiographers was held on 28<sup>th</sup> February 2023.
- ESR Coding Review for Diagnostic Imaging workforce took place with Radiography Professional Heads on 15<sup>th</sup> February 2023. A revised guidance document is currently being developed with the ESR Coding Review Project Team. The aim of this work will be to ensure that all new and existing Imaging

### **Q4 Key Achievements**

#### **Equipment and Capital Priorities Project**

- Following ratification of the Service Evaluation and Prioritisation Process (Phase 2) at the National Imaging Programme Strategy Board (NIPSB) in November 2022, and Welsh Government endorsement in December 2022 (via Nick Wood, Deputy Chief Executive NHS Wales), a paper was taken to National Diagnostics Board in February 2023 for noting, with no further comments received.
- A formal 'go live' notification has been issued to all Health Boards and Trusts to let them know this process will be implemented from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2023.
- Equipment Champions have reviewed equipment on the National Imaging Equipment Asset Register and the data will be baselined on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023 in preparation for implementation of the process.
- A Standard Operating Procedure has been drafted to accompany the evaluation forms, ensuring equipment champions have clear guidance to co-ordinate discussion and approvals at a local level.
- New Senior Project Support Officer, Clarissa Wong, joined the team on 9th January and will be providing additional support to this project as it moves into the implementation phase.
- Terms of Reference for the national review function have
